## AOC Picpoul de Pinet

### Origin

At the edge of the Mediterranean Sea, on the Gulf of Lions, along the Etang de Thau, extends the vineyard of the AOC Picpoul de Pinet on an area of 1400 Ha.

It is the largest region of white wine from the Languedoc, in the middle of a triangle AGDE - PEZENAS - SETE.



### Vinification

Very short skin maceration which varies according to the vintages and the grapes used in order to extract aromatic potential without adversely affecting the quality of the musts. Temperature-controlled alcoholic fermentation is used to preserve the wine's varietal and aromatic qualities along with its structure and length.



**Appearance :** Beautiful crystalline pale green robe.  
**Nose :** Discreet nose, fine, nice, (with acacia flower aromas of hawthorn ...).

**Palate :** nervous with good acidity for a perfect balance and structure



Serve between 12-14°C  
Best enjoyed within 1-2 years
